Purpose**

There will be a combination of payment collected from each player attending the camp plus funds from the boys basketball booster account.
We are attempting to do more fundraising to lower the costs even further for each player.

3. How will the funds be collected and safeguarded?

Coach Nate Smith will be responsible for collecting payment from each player going. This money will be kept track of accurately on a google sheet and deposited promptly within the booster account. The document will be shared with proper administration to ensure accurate and detailed record keeping.

4. How will any shortfall be made up or excess funds used?

If there happens to be a shortfall of any kind, we will use our additional fundraisers planned for the 2026/27 season. If there are excess funds, we will make sure it gets deposited into the booster account and used for the program.

If there are students who are financially unable to pay the necessary costs, they are to contact head coach Nate Smith and Nate will make sure there is a plan in place to ensure that individual can still attend the camp. Every student interested in going will be able to go regardless of financial ability.
