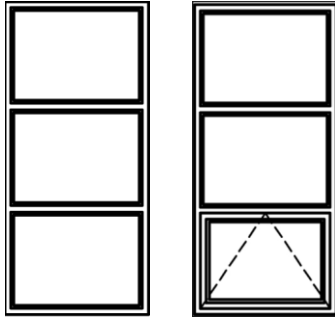

DESCRIPTION OF WINDOW MATERIALS

MODEL:

- Model 325 ES

ARRANGEMENT:



*typical window configurations

HARDWARE:

Vent Windows:

- Stainless steel four-bar friction hinges
- White bronze cam handles
- Limit blocks

WEATHER-STRIP:

- Dual perimeter weather-stripped sash

GLASS TYPE:

- 1" grey tempered Low-"E" softcoat #3 insulated glass

SCREEN TYPE:

- Sliding Wicket - standard mesh color charcoal

MINI-BLINDS:

- 5/8" between the glass blinds with 1/4" hinged clear tempered blind sash and standard blind knob operator - manufacturers' standard colors

FRAME FINISH:

- 70% 2-Coat Kynar Capitol standard "Bone White" finish

WARRANTY:

- **WINDOW:** 10 years from date of installation
- **INSULATED GLASS:** 10 years from date of installation
- **INSTALLATION:** 1 year from date of installation

Thank you for considering Capitol for your window and/or door needs. In order to provide you with a total quality, cost-effective installation, Capitol performs work first shift, Monday – Thursday during regular business hours (7:00 am – 4:00 pm). Capitol provides building owner's, whenever possible, at least 48 hours' notice prior to scheduling the date(s) for installation. If work is necessary outside these typical working hours or if the installation has to be rescheduled, then you will incur additional costs.

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NOTES & QUALIFICATIONS

- TARIFF's.** Should Tariffs implemented by our Federal Government affect any materials or products, such as aluminum, alter costs of this project, those costs will be absorbed by customer, not shared or absorbed by Capitol Aluminum in any way or form, altering final cost shown within this proposal, to customer. **Time is of the essence; materials and products purchased prior to implementation of any such Tariff will not alter performance of this proposal.**
- Any items that may interfere with the installation of the Capitol products shall be removed and reinstalled by owner. (i.e. blinds, drapes, shades, files, shelves, desks, alarms, exit signs, conduit, wiring, etc.) Any materials that contain asbestos and come in contact with the existing work shall be properly treated prior to Capitol performing labor. All costs and labor associated with this treatment shall be the responsibility of owner.
- Capitol will provide its' standard product and installation warranty unless otherwise indicated on this quote. There are no other expressed or implied warranties from Capitol Aluminum & Glass Corporation. A sample copy can be submitted if requested. Any hardware that is being reused on new Capitol products will not carry any warranty.
- If during sales survey any part of the work areas were inaccessible or not reviewed by Capitol, a price adjustment may be required dependent upon Capitol engineering survey. Any building alterations performed by others that occur after Capitol quotation and/or before Capitol installation, a change order may be required if alterations affect Capitol product sizing or opening conditions. If changes will occur, customer must notify Capitol within 72 hours.
- If cylinders are being provided by customer or others, all cylinders must be received at Capitol facility prior to engineering measure or standard lock cylinders will be provided for the project. Then the customer will be responsible to rekey all cylinders after Capitol installation.
- Note that Capitol will not release shop drawings without this signed proposal or customer purchase order.
- Customer purchase orders shall not supersede this proposal and attached terms and conditions.
- Prices are based on Capitols' lead time from point of order and during normal working hours. A price adjustment will be necessary if 2nd shift installation is required. Capitol to coordinate installations with customers when product and manpower is available.
- Please submit an executed purchase order with this signed proposal. Payment terms are Net 30 days.**
- Prices exclude final cleaning, PE stamp, tax, bond, prevailing wage rates, and liquidated damages.
