A. Purpose

1. What is the major place to be visited or event to be attended?
The camp will take place at BSS July 13-17 with one overnight lock in taking place the last night of camp on the evening of the 16th into the morning of the 17th.
2. How is the trip related to the educational program of the District?
This camp will give students time to prepare performance materials for the upcoming 2026-2027 season and for team building activities.
3. In what ways will the students benefit?
Students will be able to prepare in advance for early summer and fall performances and to create teamwork and leadership skills needed for the show choir program.
4. In what ways will the District benefit?
The District will benefit by helping to give students experiences that help them build social and leadership skills, as well as to improve their musical skills.
5. How will the trip be evaluated to determine the extent to which these benefits were realized?
During the camp, dialogue and reflection will take place about the team building, leadership, and performance preparation that is taking place. Student recruitment and retention will also be evaluated by advisors to evaluate the effectiveness of the camp benefits.
