

Then and Now Certificate – Gym Floor Refinishing Services (The Ohio Floor Company, \$8,010.00)

Rationale: This Then and Now certificate is required to authorize payment to The Ohio Floor Company for gym floor cleaning, game line touch-up, and application of two coats of water-based urethane gym floor finish for the Bucyrus Middle School and High School gymnasiums. The purchase order was issued after the commitment date; however, funds were available at the time the original obligation was incurred and remain available at the time of payment. This approval ensures compliance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(D).

WHEREAS, the Bucyrus City School District Board of Education desires to authorize the payment of this expenditure as permitted by law;
